

PA CHAPTER CHALLENGE – 2009

Set 1

This first set encourages completion of major tasks chapters will want to complete in 2009. The top five chapters will receive a significant reward which will be delivered in the November timeframe.

- Appoint and enter into the corporate database at least one Chapter Financial Advisor. April 30
- Fill/appoint at least seven elected positions. April 30
- Conduct one educational^A and one social event for Thrivent members involving FR(s). August 31
- Allocate and report at least 60% of Care Abounds in Community Funds. September 1
For every \$1 allocated, \$3 must be raised and ½ hour of volunteer time recorded.
- Have at least two chapter leaders attend a regional chapter leader event. May 1
- Record at least eight Locally Supported activities on-line; one with a fund-raising component. September 1
- Complete and report two Join Hands Day activities. August 1.
- In some way, support Thrivent Builds (fund raiser, social event). September 1
- Hold an event for Congregational Coordinators (training, celebration). June 30
- Send a mailing to congregation coordinators encouraging them to hold an event for their congregation's Thrivent members, to use their CIC funds (and report them), to bring their number of coordinators to three, and to submit names for the chapter leadership election. August 1
- Report on-line operating funds spent during the first half of the year. September 1
- Report on-line at least four chapter meetings and their minutes. September 1

Set 2

This set encourages the usual performance we seek from our chapters. This should be achievable by all chapters. Besides feeling good about doing good, the chapter leaders will be recognized in January 2010.

- Conduct four educational and/or social events^A for Thrivent members that involve FR(s), if at all possible, and different members. December 15.
- Allocate and report 100% of Care Abounds in Communities funds. December 31
For every \$1 allocated, \$3 must be raised and ½ hour of volunteer time recorded.
- Complete 2010 elections with eight elected positions filled and the leaders reported on-line as well as the election. December 15
- Submit nominations for at least two volunteers of excellence to the RFO. December 1
